

What is "SCOUTING ADVENTURES" you ask?

It is an exciting, fun filled weekend at Camp Shenandoah where Boy Scouts set up displays and demonstration areas to be seen and experienced by WEBELOS, their parents, and their leaders. This gives the Boy Scouts a chance to show how great their Troop is and why the WEBELOS should cross over their unit!

For the WEBELOS, their parents and leaders it's a chance to see Boy Scouts in action,
To get a sampling of what Boy Scouts do and how they do it.

A chance for them to spend time and camp overnight with a Boy Scout Troop they may want to join!

It's all about getting WEBELOS to see the Adventures that await them in Boy Scouts and for the Troops to recruit those WEBELOS to ensure that their unit has a steady flow of membership.

What do the Troops need to do?

1. Pick a demonstration or display area and sign up to plan, organize and operate it! Bring whatever supplies you need for your area and have it ready on Saturday when the WEBELOS arrive!
2. Turn in forms to register the youth and adults who will be attending from your Troop. Also be sure to turn in the form with your 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choice of demonstration or display area.
3. Have the Scouts in your Troop get involved with the demonstration or display area! Have them work as a team with each one doing their part or perhaps taking turns running the station.
4. Invite the WEBELOS, their parents and leaders from your local Packs to eat, camp, and spend time with your Troop during the weekend.
5. Be sure to have a leader at the WEBELOS Parent/Leader meeting to represent your unit.

What do the WEBELOS, parents and leaders need to do?

1. WEBELOS, parents and leaders are invited to take part in the fun and excitement of the demonstration and display areas and then campout on Saturday with one of the Troops.
2. Register as a Pack by turning in the registration form to sign up all the youth and adults who will be attending from your unit.
3. If you are not contacted by a Boy Scout Troop to spend the weekend, then hunt them down and tell them you want to go! If you are not sure which Troop to go with, contact us maybe we can help.
4. Attend the Parent/Leader Meeting to learn about how to help your son transition from Cub Scouts to Boy Scouts. You will also get a chance to meet with the Boy Scout Leaders to learn more about their individual units.
